Continuing Education Information

- Please [visit our continuing education page](#) for information about maintaining your full 1-year certification.
- You are required to complete 10 hours of continuing education with at least 1 hour in ethics in order to renew your certification annually.
- Continuing education (CE) is not required during your initial 6-month certification, though we encourage you to attend the conference in your area to network with your colleagues and learn valuable information to enhance your professional skills.
- You must complete your CE within your current certification period and CE that was completed prior to current certification start date will not be accepted.

- If you hold both peer and family support certifications, you are required to complete 20 unique hours of CE with at least 2 hours in ethics to renew both of your certifications annually.
