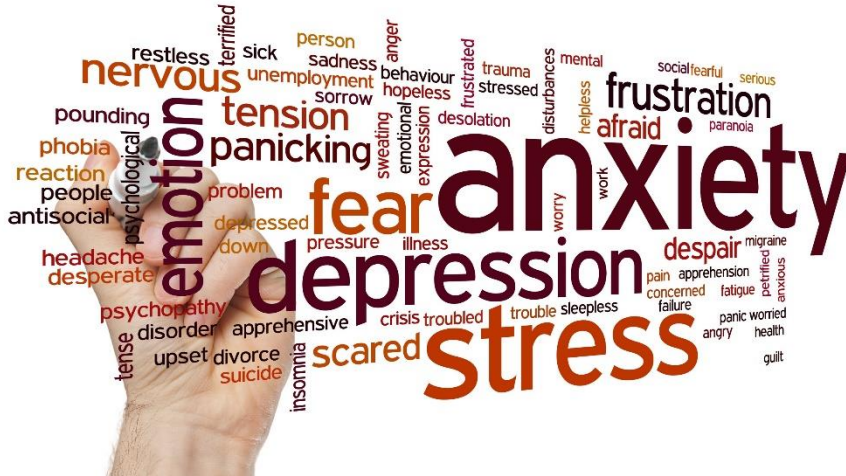


# Free 1 Day (5.0 CEs) Training
