

New Idaho Behavioral Health Plan to Launch July 1, 2024

On July 1, 2024, the new Idaho Behavioral Health Plan (IBHP) will begin serving Idaho residents. In the new IBHP, Magellan Healthcare will manage the behavioral health services for the Divisions of Behavioral Health and Medicaid. Magellan will also manage the provider network for the Department of Juvenile Corrections. This includes services that BPA Health currently manages.

What does this mean for you?

On July 1, 2024, Magellan Healthcare will help you with Substance Use Disorder services that we help you with now. Important things to know:

- Magellan will honor all authorizations from BPA Health that have been approved and span past July 1, 2024. The end date of the authorization will be the same as what BPA Health told your provider.
- Magellan will ensure that your care is not disrupted during the transition.
- Magellan will have a provider network and is working to add providers to it.
- If you get treatment or services now from a provider who is not in Magellan's network, you can keep seeing them for at least the first 90 days after July 1, 2024, and Magellan will cover the services.
- If you are a citizen of a Tribe, you can keep seeing Indian healthcare providers for as long as you need to, and Magellan will cover the services.
